#### Captains Report

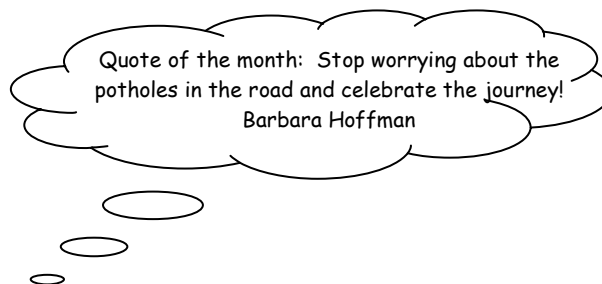
